Terrance Kelly
*Founding Artistic Director,

Terrance Kelly has garnered extensive musical credentials in both gospel and jazz music. His operatic and gospel influences combined make him a popular soloist as well as an accomplished director, composer, and arranger. His credits include choral arrangements on albums by Linda Ronstadt and the Kronos Quartet and gospel arrangements of popular music for TV and video soundtracks and has received an Emmy Award for his choral arrangement of OIGC's KGO-TV public service announcement. In 2013, he was awarded the Dr. Edwin Hawkins Excellence Award.

Mr. Kelly currently serves as Minister of Magnification at Oakland's Imani Community Church. He has traveled as far as Australia and Israel to teach gospel music and, since 1982, has served as Gospel Choir Director for Jazz Camp West, hosted by Living Jazz. His father, the late Ed Kelly, was an esteemed jazz and gospel pianist. His mother, the late Faye Kelly, was a gospel choir director and pianist.



La Nell Martin is an Oakland native and alumna of the Oakland Youth Chorus (1986-1989). She holds a B.A. in Voice from Cal State East Bay, Kodály Level One Certificate from Holy Names University, and a Masters in Music Education from San Jose State University. La Nell began conducting OYC's Middle School Chorus programs in 2004 and Concert Chorus in 2006.

La Nell serves as Children's and Community Youth Choirs rep for the Board of the California Choral Director's Association, and is a member of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA), the Association of the American Kodály Educators, and the National Association for Music Education (NAFME).

La Nell also likes to play golf, roller skate, and enjoys watching reruns of old TV shows!

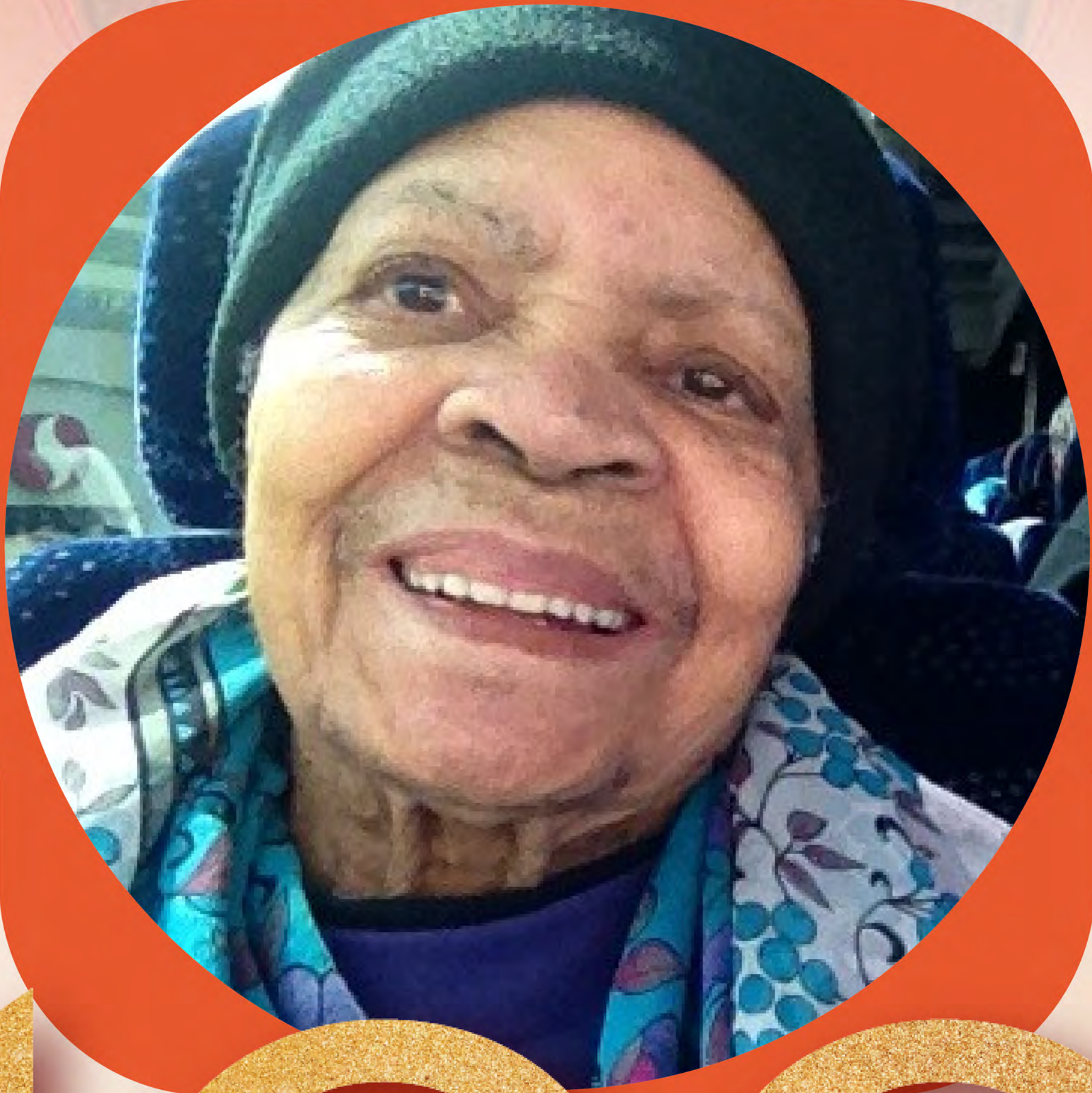

Rabbi Sydney Mintz

Rabbi Sydney Mintz has served as the Rabbi of the historic Temple Emanu-El in San Francisco for the past 25 years.

Mintz received her degree in English and graduated Cum Laude from University of Wisconsin-Madison. She attended Oxford University in the U.K. where she received her certificate in Judaic Studies. Rabbi Mintz received a Master's Degree in Hebrew Letters in 1995 and Rabbinical Ordination in 1997 from Hebrew Union College in New York City. Mintz was a Senior Rabbinic Fellow at the Shalom Hartman Institute in Jerusalem in 2004. In 2022, Rabbi Mintz was awarded her honorary Doctorate of Divinity degree by the Hebrew Union College.

Rabbi Mintz is also a writer and performer with her one woman show "You May Think I'm Funny, But It's Not," ready to hit the road again after a pause during COVID, and co-creator of the Book of Life Project with Rabbi Matthew Gewirtz and Rabbi Yoshi Zweiback.

She launched the non-profit *13th Tribe* in 2020 and is currently working on projects in the areas of Jewish spirituality, film and performance.

JaCoree Prothro



JaCoree Prothro is a singer-songwriter who has honed his musical skills by singing in church and competing in (and winning!) many talent shows. As a child he could be heard at the top of the stairs with his 'lil Granny's' cane singing and giving a show.

JaCoree has been afforded the opportunity to sing background vocals for many nationally known gospel artists and was a member of the "Community & Praise Choir" under the direction of the late legendary Edwin Hawkins. He has also performed as a lead vocalist and choir member with the International GMWA Northern California Chapter.

JaCoree is the founder of the "#LiquidLove Movement", working to stop gun violence, pushing past the sting of death in honor of his brother Jovante who was gunned down in a senseless murder.

JaCoree also serves as praise and worship leader for some of the Bay Area's greatest churches: Bethel Temple, Greater St. Paul, New Destiny, and Wellspring Church.



Jackie Tolbert

Ms. Jackie was born in Baton Rouge, LA, the second youngest of 9 children. Her family moved to Zachary, where she received her formative education. Other educational experiences include Southern University, the Christian Bible College of Louisiana, the A.P. Clay Christian Theological College and the National Bishop Theological University. Jackie relocated to New Orleans and began singing and holding workshops. Besides the United States she has toured Germany, France, Italy, Switzerland, Brazil, Spain, Morocco, Zimbabwe and Jamaica She has recently put out her first CD God Keeps His Promise. Jackie has one daughter, Sierra Trenese. She now lives in Oakland CA, where she is a member of the Market Street SDA Church.



Lady Kathi Rachea Mills

Lady Kathi, born Jan.16, 1966 to Pastor Jesse and Evangelist Norma Phai Mills (both deceased) in Gary, IN. She began singing at the age of 8 with her three brothers. She and her family later moved to Oakland in 1983, where she graduated from Castlemont High School, was a Castleleer, and led her first school song "I Need To Pray."

Kathi branched out to become a solo artist after joining Peace Gospel Choir. She currently sings for weddings, anniversaries, funerals, retirement and church events, dining establishments and much more. Her current church home is Word In The Valley, Tracy, CA where her pastor is Bishop Johnnie M. Clark, Jr.



Half-N-Half

Sherry Hicks and Michael Velez are Children of Deaf Adults (CODA) performers who collaborate and tour around the world.

This dynamic duo delights audiences with their original multimedia American Sign Language (ASL) performances, combining music and storytelling. Using improvisation and various poetic styles, they perform entertaining excerpts of Deaf and CODA life.

Half-N-Half was originally formed in 1994 by four CODA members: Sherry Hicks, Sheila Jacobs, Pam Johnson, and Michael Velez. They were called the Bay Area Coda Performers. Their first performance was for students at the awards banquet at the California School for the Deaf at Fremont. For the entertainment, musical selections were choreographed and presented in ASL. The crowd went wild, with students jumping onto the stage and joining in with the rhythm and beat.

Since then, Half-N-Half has put together almost two decades of CODA-based material. Signing songs and performing for mixed audiences, they share the gift of ASL that their families, community, and culture have instilled in them.



Joshua Carter

Joshua Carter, is a Gospel/Soul singer with a multi-octave range. Joshua began singing at the tender age of 3 years old in his church choir (Evangelistic Outreach Church), and honed his skills in his early teens traveling with the Encinal Voices of Gospel.

Through his calling in ministry, he has shared his gift at many churches, including Love Center, Acts Full Gospel, Glad Tidings and Olivet Institutional. Joshua has also performed for the Golden State Warriors and accompanied several Grammy nominated artists such as Goapele, Dave Hollister of the hit R&B Group Blackstreet, Syleena Johnson, and Ledisi.

You may have seen him performing on countless stages, including the BET Superbowl Gospel Celebration, Davies Symphony Hall, Yoshi's, Capital Jazz Festival, San Jose Jazz Festival and the Paramount Theater to name a few.

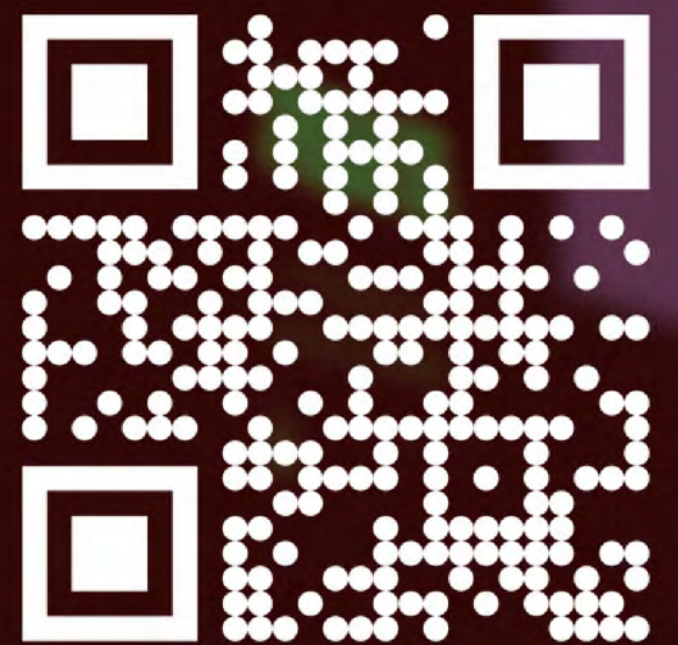
